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This workshop will teach the process and content of conjoint therapy. In dialogue and formal presentation of different schools of thought, systemic and reciprocal patterns in couples and intervention will be stressed. Special topics such as divorce and blended families will be discussed, as well as examining the role of the therapist.

Objectives: By the end of this workshop, the participants will be able to:

- 1) **Explain three or four systemic schools and their application to conjoint therapy;**
- 2) **Describe process interventions with couples**
- 3) **Identify therapeutic approaches to issues such as affairs, divorce and blended families.**

About Our Presenter: Stephen Treat D.Min, LMFT received his doctorate in Pastoral Counseling from the Andover Newton Theological Seminary in 1976 and is an ordained minister. He completed post-doctoral work in the Human Sexuality Department of the Graduate School of Education at the University of Pennsylvania and the Marriage and Family Therapy Training Program at Council for Relationships in 1981. He is licensed to practice marriage and family therapy in the state of Pennsylvania. In addition to being an Adjunct Assistant Professor in the Department of Couple and Family Therapy, College of Health Professions, Thomas Jefferson University, and an Adjunct Professor at Widener University, he is a Clinical Member and Approved Supervisor in the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy, a member of the American Association of Pastoral Counseling, and a member of the American Family Therapy Association.

Dr. Treat has co-authored two books, Pastoral Marital Therapy and Couples in Treatment: Techniques and Approaches for Effective Practice. In addition, he has published book chapters and articles on process and content of marital and family therapy. As a public speaker, Dr. Treat has been the keynote at many conferences on topics including fathers and sons, marital therapy, and spirituality.
